Last term we mentioned that there are some quite extensive roadworks planned for House Avenue and Muir Avenue. Due to COVID-19, these works were put on hold and now the good people at Higgins who will oversee this project have let us know they are on again, starting this Monday 22 June. As we mentioned last term, if you drive your children and drop them off outside school it would pay to have a plan as to how you will do things differently in terms of pickups and drop offs. Our understanding is that House Ave will be a **no stopping, one way system** and the current parking outside the school will not be available. We will all need to demonstrate our Manaakitanga as we navigate the new arrangement.

Here are some possible alternative parking ideas:

- Drop children off in Sullivan Avenue for them to walk through Waterlea Park to school.
- Drop children off on Seaforth Avenue and children walk up Nadine Place to the back gate of the school
- Drop children off on Ambury Road and children cross at the crossing to school.
- Drop your children at a Walking School Bus pick up point

These roadworks also give families an opportunity to walk to school. 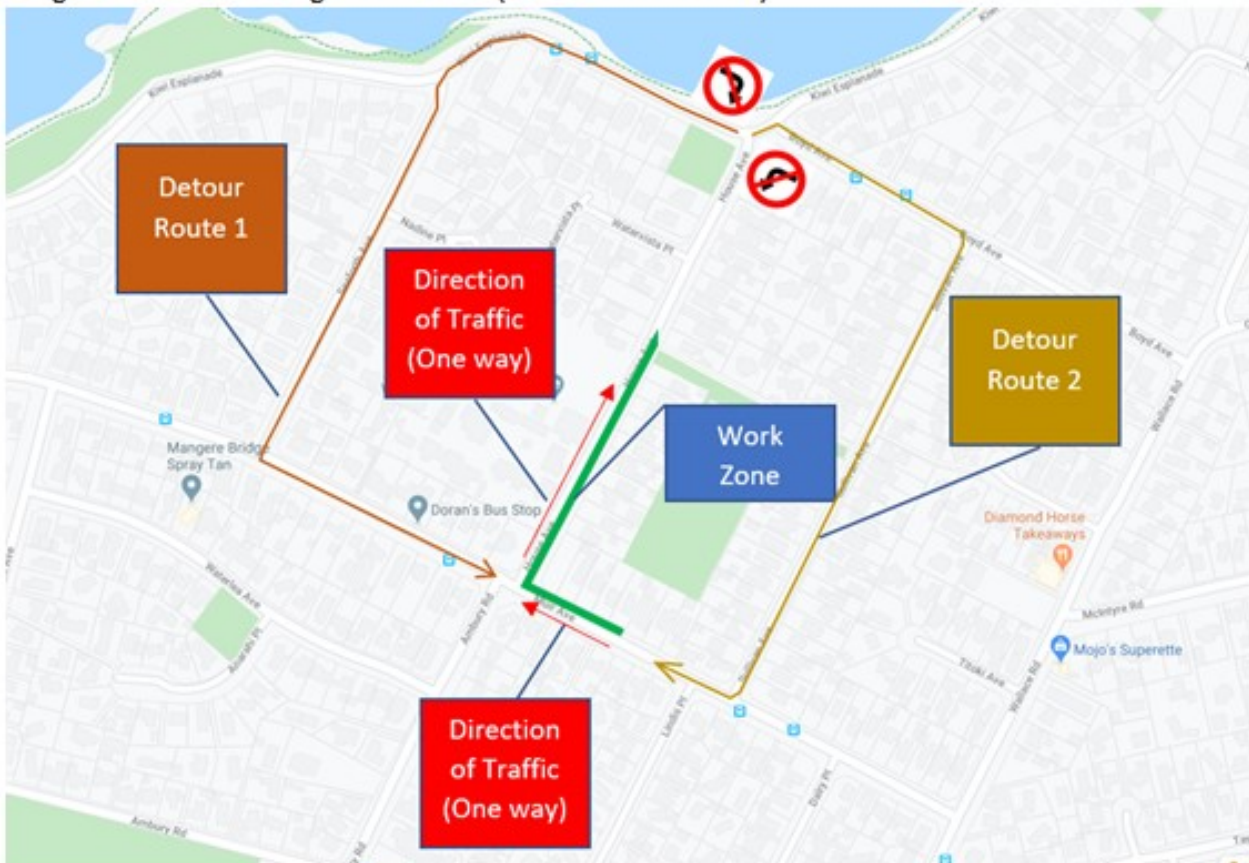

These minor works include: Speed table construction, footpath improvements, traffic islands, line-markings and safety surfacing.
