It was lovely to meet so many of you last Friday at our Waterlea Welcome Assembly where we formally welcomed our new tamariki and whānau to Waterlea School. We'd like to thank our Kapa Haka who demonstrated their Manaakitanga to you all and their leaders Whaea Aroha and Hamish Bennett who support them every week to continually develop their te reo, tikanga and performance skills.

We are a culturally diverse community at Waterlea and the more we know about the different cultures we have the stronger our community will be. It is at this time that we acknowledge those celebrating Eid al-Fitr or Eid as it is better known. Eid is celebrated by Muslims around the world to mark the end of Ramadan, the Islamic holy month of fasting which happened a couple of months ago. It is a joyous holiday that follows four weeks of fasting between dawn and sunset. Eid al-Fitr means the festival of breaking the fast in Arabic. The occasion is one of two that Muslims celebrate, with Eid al-Adha being celebrated this week. This celebration signals the first day of Shawwal, a new month in the Islamic calendar. Some countries may celebrate Eid on different days due to the sighting of the moon in their country.

If you are new to Waterlea School you won't yet know about our Student Led Conferences (SLC). These are an important part of the teaching and learning programmes at Waterlea because they create an authentic way for students to celebrate, reflect upon and share their learning with their Whānau. Some of the learning they will share will be individual and some will be learning that has occurred through the collaboration with others.
