# Easter Holidays and Teacher Only Day: School Closed 2-7 April

We have had some queries regarding the **Easter break coming up April 2-6.** In some years, the Easter break falls within the school holidays. This year the Easter break falls outside the holidays which means all NZ schools are closed for an additional day - the Tuesday following Easter - even though Tuesday 6 is not an official NZ public holiday.

Our Kahui Ako or cluster of schools have planned a **Teacher Only Day on Wednesday 7 April** and school will be closed on this day also. We have had this event planned since last year. All our cluster schools will come together at Makaurau Marae, Ihumatao, to learn the stories of the local whenua. It is important that we keep this date. Going forward we have decided to cancel the other two Teacher Only Days planned for later in the year due to the disruptions we have had in school closures this term.

We thank you for your understanding and look forward to seeing all our tamariki back in school on **Thursday 8 April**.

### Pokémon Cards

There has been an increase in children wanting to bring Pokémon cards into school to play and trade with others. As a school, we appreciate that this is an enjoyable and often problem-free activity, however from time to time these things can interfere with learning. For Years 1-4, we are asking that all cards stay at home. We are working on creating an opportunity for these children to bring cards/toys in on a specific day during the term; keep your eye out for this.

manage and monitor their use. As there is always a risk of cards being damaged or going missing, we ask that you discuss this risk with your children and if they are not comfortable, they do not bring their cards into school.

Waterlea is hosting a wonderful, free parenting programme 'The Incredible Years' in the David Lange Hall - every Wednesday 9.30am-12pm for the next 14 weeks. If you are interested in attending, please come along and register in the hall next Wednesday 17 March at 9.30am.

What is the Incredible Years Parent programme? Incredible Years Parent is a 14-session programme for parents of children aged 3–8, which provides parents with skills to better manage children by creating a home environment that is conducive to positive social and educational outcomes.

### The programme looks at:

making time to play and spend quality time with children and letting children lead the play encouraging the behaviours parents would like to see, through setting clear rules and boundaries and using praise and encouragement selectively using consequences, such as ignoring, loss of privilege, and time out. Parents learn from each other and support each other.
