Waterlea School's Board of Trustees have been working hard behind the scenes developing a comprehensive property plan for the next couple of years. Every five years the government gives schools some money to address property issues. The board then identifies and prioritises the most urgent property issues and makes plans to remediate them. The board is focusing on refurbishing Rooms 9-12 with new wall and floor coverings. Also some roof and flooring issues will be fixed as well. In order for this work to be completed children will need to shift into the hall to do their learning. We knew this was on the cards for later this year but we weren't expecting it to happen so quickly. In fact, Room 9 will begin their shift into the hall this week because we were notified yesterday that work will begin in their classroom as early as Friday. After the refurbishment of Room 9 is completed it will be the turn of Rm 10, 11 and 12 to temporarily shift into the hall. The following term will see the senior school refurbishment get underway. Our school is over 60 years old and many classrooms are needing some TLC so a little disruption now will be beneficial in the long run.
