Take the opportunity to have a day off from making lunches!!

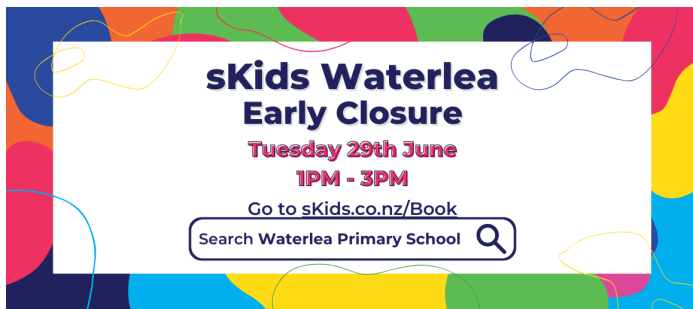
