Welcome to Term 3 and we hope all our tamariki and kaiako had a good break. Last week many of our tamariki chose to spend the last week of the holidays at school to attend our DMIC Holiday programme. This was hosted at Waterlea, but facilitated by the DMIC (developing mathematical inquiry communities) mentors from Massey University. The programme's focus was engaging in STEM or Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics activities. 170 of our tamariki enrolled in the programme at the end of the term and we had over 100 students on-site each day. The children rotated around activities, including a maths lesson and creating and exploring with fun technology such as beebot robots, lego trains, gravitrax, brain boxes, meccano and more.





A big thanks to Don Biltcliff and the DMIC team for making this valuable learning experience happen for our children. Waterlea collaborated with DMIC to offer some additional

learning opportunities for our tamariki in response to our experience of learning disruptions over the last couple of years.
