You may be aware that COVID-19 cases are currently increasing in the community. There have been public health warnings and stories in the media that this trend may potentially build, possibly surging to a new 'wave' over the summer.

This is no cause for alarm as our school health and safety measures have proven effective during peak COVID cases before, and we continue to take appropriate precautions in line with official health advice.

With this in mind, it is a good opportunity to remind ourselves of the measures we can take to reduce the possible spread within our school.

How can you help:

Collective action has been key to the success of our response. As before, helping us to reduce transmission risk at school comes down to a few simple steps:

- Keep your child at home if they are feeling unwell
- Test to rule COVID in or out if they are sick
- Notify us of a positive case as soon as possible using the school absence form, or by ringing the office
- If your child is a household contact (someone else in their house has tested positive), they do not need to isolate, however it is recommended that they complete a RAT test daily for 5 days

The Start of the 2023 School Year

We will be starting the new school year with our Waterlea Wānanga. This is when we make time for your child's teacher to meet with you and your child in a 15 minute hui. In this meeting we want to hear from you about your child so that we

understand a bit more about them before the year starts. Wānanga will be held on Wednesday 1 February starting at 8.30am until 4.30pm. SKIDs will be open that day for childcare. Contact 0800 900 754 for more information from them.

Information on how to book your wānanga will come out over the next few weeks. This can be booked once you know your child's class/teacher for next year - after they have met their teacher on 12 December.

Thursday 2 February, all children will be at school for their first full day, starting at our usual time of 8.50am This will be followed by our Waterlea Powhiri at 9.15am. This is an opportunity for all whānau, tamariki and staff new to Waterlea to be formally welcomed.

During this time, you will be able to cross the Manukau Harbour via the SH20 underpass and security guards will be on duty.









TICKETS

Farly-bird tickets and DISCO DOLLAR sales will be outside the school hall on 29 November, 30 November and 1 December between 2.45pm and 3.15pm. The early-bird cost is \$3 per child. \$4 door sales will also be available on the night.

DISCO DOLLARS

\$1 is equivalent to 1 DISCO DOLLAR.
Official "DISCO DOLLARS" can only be used for purchasing items and activities inside. We advise that you pre-purchase "DISCO DOLLARS" prior to coming to the disco to avoid lengthy queues.

Eftpos will be available on the night to purchase "DISCO DOLLARS" if required, however, we will only have one terminal operating.

PRE-SCHOOL CHILDREN

Pre-school children are able to attend the disco for free. Note the event will have loud music, be darkened to allow neon lights to glow and there may be strobe lighting used at times.

HOW TO AVOID QUEUES ON THE NIGHT

If you have purchased an early bird ticket, please ensure your child is wearing their wristband. This will allow them and yourself to walk through the pre-sales line quickly and start dancing sooner. We also advise to purchase DISCO DOLLARS prior to avoid any queues too!
