Since the beginning of the year we have been tracking and monitoring our overall attendance rates at Waterlea School. Looking closely at attendance is one of the factors we explore when we are looking at improving overall student achievement. In regards to school attendance it is useful to understand some important data information. Regular school attendance is when children are attending school more than 90% of the time. If children are attending about 89-90% of the time it means that on average they are absent from school one day every fortnight. This in itself might not sound like it would have much impact on learning. It is when we look at this rate over time that it paints quite a different picture. One day a fortnight over a whole year adds up to missing about 1 month of learning. Over 6 years of primary school adds up to about half a year of learning!

Last week our overall attendance rate was 91% which is great as 90% or more is considered ideal. This is positive news because being at school everyday gives our tamariki the best chance of making progress in their learning and developing good routines which will set them up for lifelong learning. Even though our overall attendance rate is good we are keen to work closely with families who might be struggling to get their children to school regularly. If you

Hi all! Just a reminder to you all that Library books are due back to our school library each week.


