Kia Orāna kōtou kātoatoa and welcome to 'Epetoma o te reo Māori Kūki 'Āirani - Cook Islands Language Week. The theme this year is 'Ātuitui'ia au ki te au peu o tōku kāinga Ipukarea, which means, "connect me to the traditions & culture of my homeland". This is an extension of last year's theme of 'Ātuitui'ia au ki te Oneone o tōku 'Ui Tupuna, or "connect me to the soil of my ancestors". Setting the theme for Epetoma o te reo Māori Kūki 'Āirani is about intentionally deepening the bonds of our people to their language through their family ties, through the cultural traditions of their enua/vaka, and the songs, dance and pe'e's of their family.
