
Towards the end of the term we will be inviting whaanau to come to school for a Teacher Led Conference (TLC) to discuss children's learning. At this time, the mid-year school report will come home too. As part of this school report, we will be reporting on the progress your child has made since the beginning of the year and their overall attendance rate. To have regular attendance at school, children need to be here 90% of the time, or have less than 5 days at home per term. When there are more than 5 days at home per term, the attendance rate drops below 90% and is seen as irregular. In terms of attendance, the school day is divided into half - the morning is the first half and the afternoon is the second half of the day. Children need to be at school for the whole day for them to be marked present. If you are picking children up earlier than 3pm they will be marked absent for the afternoon half of the day which over time will impact children's overall attendance rates. Therefore, you might not even be aware that your child's attendance rate has become irregular. As a school we are aiming to have 90-95% (or attendance each week and so far this year we are on track at 90%, giving us some time to increase this by the end of the year. If you are wanting support in this area of school attendance, please let us know.





### **Property Update**

When driving or walking past the school you might have noticed we have two new lovely blue shade sails up, covering the Middle and Senior School's playgrounds. They will be very useful through the summer and winter months protecting our tamariki from the sun and rain when they are playing. Over the coming weeks we are hoping to have the cover for the Junior School playground completed as well as the canopy attached to Rooms 5-8. Thanks to the Board of Trustees Property Committee who have worked hard behind the scenes, supporting the school to plan and oversee the completion of these building projects.
