Welcome to Week 2 of Term 4 and just a reminder it will be a short week both this week with Teacher Only Day on Friday and next Monday being the public holiday, Labour Day. In a few weeks time the teachers and leaders will start our class placement process for 2025. At the end of each year we farewell some staff, appoint new staff and change year levels of existing classes according to the needs of the school. This year is no different and in the next couple of weeks we will communicate via this newsletter any staff changes that will be coming up in 2025. The class placement process is an important part of organising the school for the coming year and involves staff, leaders and whaanau. When the staff organisation for next year has been finalised and communicated to you, we will invite you to contact our deputy principals, Camilla and Andy with any information you might have which could help us in this process, e.g. information regarding friendships that support your child's learning etc. We intend to trial some software whereby our teachers can input a variety of information and then class lists are created for us to review and make adjustments to if necessary. Look out for this information in the next couple of weeks. During this week's Teacher Only Day on Friday, our staff is looking at the refreshed NZ Curriculum in Writing in preparation for next year. There has been some discussion in the media with regards to Teacher Only Days and it is important for you to know that Waterlea only plans such days as we are required to do by the Ministry of Education. This will be our second this year as required and in 2025 the Ministry is asking schools to hold 2 more. These days are in addition to the ones we hold during holiday times and help the school provide professional learning development for our teachers in response to this time of educational change. Further to this point, in 2025 we are extending the Better Start Literacy Approach (BSLA) to Year 3 & 4. BSLA has been successfully introduced to the Year 1 & 2 tamariki and we have seen very positive impacts to our youngest children's literacy development. We intend to build upon this literacy foundation as tamariki leave the junior part of the school and transition into the Middle School.





Daily Absent Texts

A reminder to reply to the daily absent text you receive when your child has not come to school.

This ensures we have not made an error and can code the absence correctly in our system.

If we do not receive a reply we will try to ring you directly and if this fails, your child will be marked as truant.

Absence due to Medical Reasons

If your child is absent for more than 2 days due to medical reasons we require a medical certificate to be sent to the school office.

Keeping Ourselves Safe

During Term 4, we will be teaching the personal safety programme Keeping Ourselves Safe.

Keeping Ourselves Safe enables children to learn and apply a range of safety skills that they can use when interacting with others. Children recognise the differences between healthy and unhealthy relationships, and information about how and when to seek help is shared.

Keeping Ourselves Safe will be taught by your child's teacher, over a few sessions, with support from the local Police Education Officer Priscilla.

Year 3-6 will be learning how to identify potentially unsafe situations involving other people in both the real and the digital worlds. These situations may involve people they know, new people they meet, and people they only know through online communications. In the real world, people who wish to harm children are most likely to be known to them. In the digital world, the harm may come from people they know through email, cell phone or chat room messages, or from people they meet in social networking sites. What the programme will look like for Year 1 and 2 will be communicated later in the term.

This is a really valuable learning experience for all tamariki. The programme will be delivered during a few sessions over the term. 
