



Our whole school attendance rate for Term 2, 2025 was 64% (the percentage of tamariki attending school over 90% of the time). Our whole school attendance rate for Term 1,2025 was 76%. The national attendance rate goal is 80%.

ABOUT IY AUTISM PARENT

The Incredible Years programme for caregivers is based on 30 years of research and includes an autism-specific course. Developed by Dr Carolyn Webster-Stratton, it provides caregivers with strategies to navigate and thrive through the unknown and diverse behaviours of their autistic tamariki. It's evidence-based, meaning there's a wealth of research proving its effectiveness.

WHAT WILL YOU LEARN?

You will learn strategies to communicate and have a positive relationship with your tamariki who may see the world in a different way. Often this is less about the child and more about your response as a caregiver. You'll learn to reflect on your behaviour and play at their level to meet their needs.

ABOUT THE COURSE

Hear Our Story facilitators are collaborating with the Ministry of Education to support whānau and tamariki in implementing the Incredible Years (IY) strategies."

WHO CAN ATTEND?

Any caregiver who is struggling with the behaviour of their autistic tamariki can attend the course. Whether your child expresses distress, sensory overload, meltdowns or intense interests, there are no judgements or comparisons. If you feel at a loss, isolated or worried, you are not alone
