This week marks a special time in Aoteroa, Te Wiki o te Reo Maaori, or Maaori Language Week. It's a fantastic opportunity for all of us to celebrate and revitalise the unique language of te Reo Maaori.

Maaori is an official language of New Zealand, and its rich history is deeply intertwined with the identity of the nation. Te Wiki o te Reo Maaori is a chance to acknowledge this heritage and encourage its use in our daily lives.

This year's theme is Kia Kaha te Reo Maaori, which means 'let's make the Maaori language strong'. It's a call to action for everyone to do their part in ensuring the language thrives for generations to come. You can join us on Friday at 12pm at our Te wiki o te Reo Maaori/MANA assembly and by sponsoring our tamariki for our te Reo Maaori-a-thon. The proceeds from this will cover the cost of Kapa Haka Uniforms, some te Reo Maaori resources and our Kapa Haka tutor.

Last week we had a great turnout for our Student Led Conferences. We had about 92% attendance on the day and have been catching up with whaanau this week too. This is our final week for Term 3 and just a reminder that the school is closed for 2 weeks and then opens again on Monday 6 October.

#### POTENTIAL STRIKE ACTION NEXT TERM

Many of you will have heard in the media, there is a possibility the support staff, primary teachers and principals will go on strike on Thursday October 23. This is due to minimal progress in collective agreement negotiations with the government. There is a hope that NZEI (primary teacher's union) and the government will reach an agreement within the timeframe so the strike does not go ahead. Most of the teachers at Waterlea are members of NZEI (the teacher's union) and if the strike goes ahead, the Board of Trustees will decide on the appropriate action. We will keep you informed of any developments.


#### **Y3-6 Cross Country Day**

#### Senior School Tapuwae Tournament

A Tapuwae tournament is being played this term in the Senior School. In the tournament all the senior classes play Tapuwae against each other and the final scores will decide the semi-finals and the ultimate showdown.

What the game looks like and what you need. To play Tapuwae you will need: two bottles, and at least 20 people - 2 keepers, 6 or more shooters, defenders and middle guards, and a top court.

How to play Tapuwae. There are four different positions you can play in Tapuwae: shooters, defenders, keepers and middle guards. Keepers(goalies) try to protect the bottle by stopping the shooters from knocking it over, they can throw or kick it out of the ring. Shooters - shooters are the people who try to knock the bottle over.


# scholastic Book Fair








#### **Attendance**


