Nǐ hǎo (Mandarin) or Néih hóu (Cantonese) and welcome to New Zealand Chinese Language Week (NZCLW). Chinese Language Week is a New Zealand initiative launched in 2014 and is designed to increase Chinese language learning in New Zealand. The first of its kind in any Western country, NZCLW seeks to bridge the cultural and linguistic knowledge gap between China and New Zealand by delivering fun and practical initiatives that assist Kiwis to learn Chinese. Room 12 kicked off NZCLW on Monday in style by making dumplings which they shared with the office staff and we can report they were delicious! Did you know there are approximately 990 million people in China who speak some variety of Mandarin as their first language. The total number of people in China who can speak Mandarin is significantly higher than those who speak Cantonese, which is only about 20% of China's population. Join us this coming Friday for our Chinese Language/MANA assembly where some of our tamariki will teach us more about Chinese culture and languages.











How to make Chinese dumplings

Have you ever made dumplings? If not, listen closely.

First, dip water on your finger and trace it around your dumpling wrapper. This makes your dumpling wrap sticky. Next, scoop some filling onto your dumpling wrapper. After that, close the dumpling carefully. Finally, you cook it for five to six minutes in a frying pan.

These crispy dumplings can be served with sweet chilli sauce, soy sauce or any sauce you like.

Chinese dumplings are delicious and easy to make.



























