There has been lots of coverage in the media over the last few weeks in regards to the increase of measles cases in Aotearoa.

If there is a confirmed case at Waterlea School:

All parents will be notified.

Waterlea will follow Ministry of Health advice, they will help us identify close contacts at school and advise us with next step actions.

Next steps might include asking certain children/adults or groups of children to stay home for a determined amount of time.

We have updated our vaccination records and will contact you if there are any confusions.

According to the Ministry of Health, if your child has had 2 measles vaccinations they have 99% immunity against measles.

If Waterlea has a measles case and your child has had only 1 or no vaccinations, they might be asked to stay home as a precaution.

If you have any questions regarding measles immunisation and vaccinations, phone your doctor in the first instance. If you'd like to update school on your child's vaccination status, phone the office on 09 6364233. Some parents have been emailed asking you to update your child's vaccination status. If we don't hear back from you we will follow up with a phone call.

It was great to have so many parents at our MANA assembly last Friday including some of our Niuean whaanau who supported our Niuean Haka Group in their performance. A special thanks to Whaea Jenny and in keeping with the Niuean theme, thanks to Whaea Annabel for supporting our Ukulele group in teaching the Niuean waiata and actions to the school at the assembly. Whaea Annabel holds our Ukulele Group on Thursday mornings before school each week and this Thursday at 8am, they are performing for their parents. If your child is in the Ukulele Group, come along to Room 10 at 8am to see these fine musicians.



# ROYAL OAK INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL ORIENTATION DAY




